FOCUS ON... ST PETERSBURG

Founded in 1703 by Tzar Peter the Great, Saint Petersburg has kept its original aura and is still one of the world's most beautiful cities. It is listed as a UNESCO world heritage site. Bathed by the waters of the Neva, the "Venice of the North" boasts an impressive wealth of historic and artistic features. From the emblematic Nevsky Prospekt, the city's main thoroughfare, exploring the city by foot is a pleasure. With its baroque cathedrals, imperial palaces, suspended bridges, theatres and museums, Saint Petersburg is a jewel of a city. To make the experience even quainter, take a boat ride along the canals through the ancient capital of the Czars.
