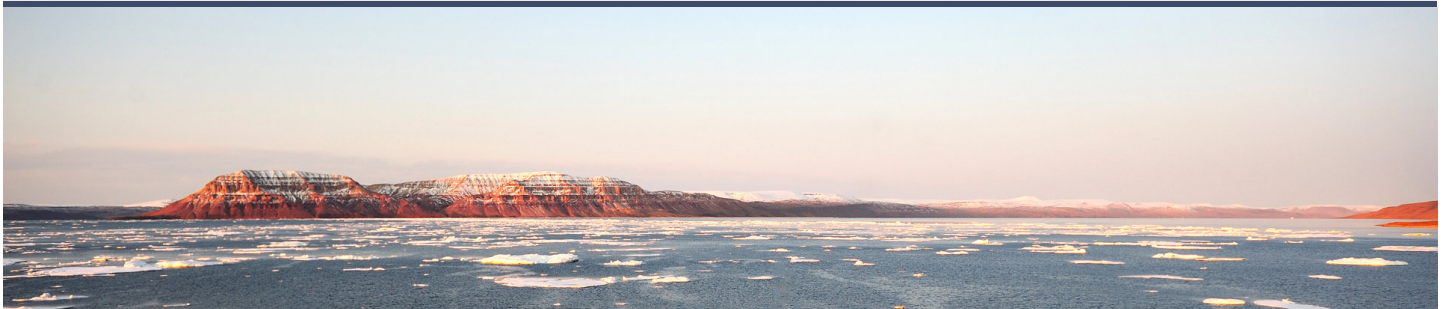

Fishing, reindeer rearing sledge-racing, here people live from their manual labour.
