You will also see the remains of ancient Inuit civilisations and will discover Savissivik, the largest "iceberg graveyard" in Greenland.

During the last days of your cruise, *L'Austral* will sail along the eastern coast of Baffin Island, in the Nunavut, Canada. With its immense cliffs, bird colonies and fjords, this destination will definitely delight you.

We are privileged guests in these remote lands where we are at the mercy of weather, ice, tidal and current conditions. Landings on certain sites and the observation of certain wildlife cannot be guaranteed. They vary from day to day, making each PONANT cruise a unique experience.
