Your ship will then set sail towards Montenegro, for an unforgettable cruise in the Bay of Kotor. This impressive gash between two mountain ranges is home to a veritable inland lake with a magical atmosphere; the medieval city of Kotor and its many historical monuments are its jewels.

Then it will be on to Greece with a first stop in Corfu, the most famous of the Ionian Islands. Once Byzantine and later Venetian, the island was visited by Ulysses and was a favourite holiday spot of Empress Sissi. Its sumptuous Neoclassical buildings and its lush and flowery vegetation are just some of its attractions.

Your voyage continues towards Itea, not far from the marvelous Delphi archaeological site.

You will cross the Corinth Canal before arriving in Nafplion, the departure point for visiting the famous Epidaurus Theatre and the Mycenae site, listed as a World Heritage Sites by UNESCO.

Your cruise will end in Athens, the mythical city dominated by the Acropolis and its monuments that form the most extraordinary architectural and artistic collection bequeathed by Ancient Greece to the rest of the world.
